This scholarship was established in honour of Dr Barrie Strafford and his commitment to improving the lives of older adults.

DURATION:	One year
ELIGIBILITY:	<p>Open to students registered full-time in a master's program in the Faculty of Graduate Studies.</p> <p>In addition to the research proposal, students must submit a brief statement (500 words or less) describing (i) how their research is shaped by an interdisciplinary perspective (i.e., methodology, composition of supervisory committee, community partnerships, etc.); and (ii) ways that their project may contribute to improving the lives of older adults and/or optimizing conditions that support aging well at a population level.</p> <p>Students are expected to apply for all provincial, national and external awards they are eligible for. Students who win other awards will have the Strafford Scholarship adjusted for a combined value of \$25,000 during the tenure of both awards.</p> <p>Recipients will receive a \$2,500 research allowance per annum. The research allowance is reserved to cover costs associated with special equipment, conferences and/or travel in direct connection with the research. In order to receive the allowance, students must submit a letter to gsaward@ucalgary.ca outlining the proposed use of funds. This statement must be signed by the supervisor approving the use. No receipts are required.</p>
