- W21C Certificate Course in Patient Safety and Quality Management
 - Designed for healthcare professionals who want to expand their working understanding of concepts in patient safety and quality management
 - Online sessions once a week from September until March with 4 in-person sessions
- UofA School of Public Health – Fellowship in Health System Improvement
 - Targets current leaders or senior managers in health systems
 - Program runs over 5 weekends
- Evidence-based Practice for Improving Quality (EPIQ) program connected with the AIW yellow belt
 - Alberta Health Services Improvement Way (AIW) Fundamentals
 - AIW is **internal** to all AHS staff and medical staff
