### Karen Benzies, PhD

A serial academic entrepreneur, Karen Benzies practiced clinically as a nurse and midwife. She holds a PhD and two post-doctoral fellowships (Stockholm and Ottawa) and served as UCalgary Nursing's Associate Dean Research and Acting Dean. Karen acquired \$33 million in operating grants and led multiple large teams to generate over 140 research publications.






