



Dr. Braden Manns, MD

Braden Manns is a professor in Health Economics and a Kidney Specialist at the University of Calgary in the Faculty of Medicine. He has expertise in Applied Health Economics, and his current research interests include examining the cost-effectiveness of health care policies for managing patients with chronic disease, and assessing the impact of different physician payment models. He holds a CIHR Foundation award in health system funding and was the co-PI of a CIHR funded patient-oriented research network in chronic disease (www.Cansolveckd.ca). He has experience in health system administration, having recently served as Alberta Health Services (AHS) Associate Chief Medical Officer and lead for the Strategic Clinical networks for six years. Between 2021 and 2023, he served as Interim AHS Vice President for two different portfolios.
