



Dr. Eddy Lang, MD

Eddy Lang is a professor and department head for emergency medicine at Cumming School of Medicine, University of Calgary and Alberta Health Services, Calgary Zone. His areas of interest are knowledge translation, evidence-based medicine and operations research. He is a member of the GRADE working group and has led the development of GRADE-based clinical practice guidelines in pre-hospital care in the US as well as with the International Liaison Committee for Resuscitation. Dr. Lang is also an award-winning educator having received recognition at both the university, national and international levels. He also serves as Senior Editor for the Canadian Journal of Emergency Medicine, Associate Editor for both ACP Journal Club and the International Journal of Emergency Medicine. In addition, he is a member of the Canadian Task Force on Preventive Health Care (CTFPHC). Dr. Lang chaired the Canadian Association of Emergency Physicians Conference (CAEP) 2018 and he was appointed as the Scientific Director of the Emergency Strategic Clinical Network (ESCN) in Alberta in 2019. Dr. Lang chaired the 2022 Preventing Overdiagnosis Conference in Calgary. He was also inducted as a Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences in 2022 and became a certificant of the Canadian College of Physician Executives in the same year.
